

By order of local authorities, on-location filming has been shut down in the City and County of Sacramento. Limitations and restrictions on business activity and public gatherings, with consequences for film production on-location, are now in effect across Sacramento County. Sacramento Office of Film + Media is not accepting or processing any applications to film currently.
