2020-21 ASSEMBLIES

Any Given Child is a program developed in partnership with The Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts to provide access and equity to arts education during the school day for K-8 students. Administered by the Sacramento Office of Arts & Culture, Any Given Child - Sacramento includes three main components for participating school districts in Sacramento County: (1) teaching artist residencies; (2) **arts exposure experiences**; and (3) professional development in arts integration.

YOUR ARTS EXPOSURE EXPERIENCE ASSEMBLY WILL:

- Be provided by a panel selected arts organization
- Promote student understanding, interaction, and involvement around an art form
- Accommodate 100-600 students at a time
- Be approximately 45 minutes in duration, if you would like this broken up into shorter segments please specify in comments.
- Be available during school hours within the school year, September-June

Should you need more than one assembly to accommodate your entire school and your school district only covers the cost of one assembly, you are welcome to purchase a second assembly for \$350, paid directly to the artist.

Please rank the artist/disciplines in order of preference on the Assembly Request Form. We will try our best to accommodate your requests.

Please note that an assembly is NOT considered an Any Given Child Assembly unless the confirmation comes from the office of the Sacramento Office of Arts & Culture **only**. Arts organizations cannot confirm or approve assemblies that are covered through the Any Given Child program. If you schedule directly with an arts organization, this assembly may not be covered through Any Given Child, which means your school is responsible for the cost of this assembly.
